The Equator is an invisible line around the middle of the Earth.

The Tropic of Cancer is north of the Equator. The Tropic of Capricorn is south of the Equator. Lines of longitude run from north to south. Lines of latitude run east to west.

The 8 points on a compass which are North, North East, East, South East, South, South West, West and North West
